## **SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

#### 1. Rights of Public Entity

The BIPA reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

#### 2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II;
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

#### 3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 30 days from the date of submission deadline.

#### 4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid company Registration Certificate;
- (b) Have a proof of payment copy on BIPA's Annual Duties;
- (b) have an original valid good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) have an original valid good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) have a certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs);

#### 5. Delivery

Delivery shall not be more than **3 months** after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period *shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable*.

- 5.1. The following tests and inspections will be conducted on the goods at delivery:
- 5.2. Goods are delivered in the sealed and good condition

#### 6. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

#### 7. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Business and Intellectual Property Authority, PZN Building, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor- 3 Ruhr Street, Northern Industrial Area, Windhoek, not later than Wednesday, 06 July 2022 by 12H00. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach the same place by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

#### 8. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by BIPA immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 7 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

#### 9. Evaluation of Quotations

BIPA shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

#### 10. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

#### 11. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.

#### 12. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

#### 13. Notification of Award and Debriefing

BIPA shall after award of contract promptly inform all unsuccessful bidders in writing of the name and address of the successful bidder and the contract amount and post a notice of award on its website within seven (7) days. Furthermore, the Public Entity shall attend to all requests for debriefing made in writing within seven (7) days of the unsuccessful bidders being informed of the award.
